*Lisdoonvarna, County Clare, was formerly a spa town where Victorian society partook of the mineral waters that were thought to have healing properties. The name Lisdoonvarna is from the Irish Gaelic 'Lios Dúin Bhearna', meaning something like 'Enclosure at the Fort by the Gap'.*
